



# Associate in Fine Arts in Visual Art: Studio Art Pathway

**All Pathways are design to transfer to a four-year institution for eventual completion of a BA/BS or BFA degree.**

The AFA degree requires students to take a significant concentration (31-34 credit hours) of art courses that are generally taught in the first two years of college. Students wishing to further their education in studio arts should consider this AFA option. Graduates in this career path will generally pursue careers such as ceramics, painting, sculpture, metal design, printmaking, art history, art education or teaching, museum studies, textile design, interior design or architecture.
