# Career and College Promise (CCP)

# Students with a college associates degree will earn at least \$400,000 more in their lifetime than someone who only has a high

### school diploma\*



\* According to the U.S. Census Bureau of Labor Statistics



Students who earn 20 or more credit hours through dual enrollment are 40% more likely to complete a 4 year degree as compared to those without dual enrollment credits (NACEP, 2017).

Students who successfully complete at least one dual enrollment class are 16% more likely to persist to high school graduation and that number increases and the number of earned credits increases (NACEP, 2017).

### What are Pathways?

#### • Career-Technical Pathways

- Curriculum determined by community college
- Some courses within the pathway will transfer
- Provides hands-on training

#### **o College Transfer Pathways**

- Designed to transfer to a University
  - Associate in Arts Pathway
  - Associate in Science Pathway
  - Associate in Engineering Pathway
  - Associate in Fine Arts Pathway
- UGETC (Universal General Education Transfer Credits)
  Transferrable to all 16 UNC schools and many private 4-year colleges in NC





Career and Technical Education Pathways A-B Tech currently offers 30 <u>Career-Technical Education</u> Certificate/diploma pathways for high school students

#### **Admission Criteria**

- Junior or Senior
- Unweighted GPA of 2.8 in high school or College readiness via placement or standardized testing
- GPA may be waived for SOME CTE pathways with approval of the principal
- Maintain good academic standing at A-B Tech
- May take up to two career-technical pathways at one time or one career-technical and a college transfer pathway.
- Pathway COMPLETE = may continue in the associated degree or diploma











### **College Transfer Pathway Options**

## **Pathways**

- Four available pathways
  - Associate of Arts
  - Associate of Engineering
  - Associate of Fine Arts
  - Associate of Science
- All courses transfer within the UNC
  System
- Counts towards University General
  Education Transfer Courses (UGETC)
- May count as AP Level Weight in your high school GPA







### **College Transfer Pathway Admission Criteria**

#### ✓ Must be junior or senior

- ✓ Unweighted GPA of 2.8 in high school course work
  <u>OR</u>
- ✓ Demonstrate college readiness via placement test
  - Place into college-level English and Math
  - Can mix and match scores from more than one testing assessment
  - ACT, SAT, Pre-ACT, PLAN, PSAT, RISE placement test
  - Maintain good academic standing at A-B Tech
- ✓ May only enroll into one transfer pathway at a time or one college transfer and one career-technical pathway.



### Additional College Transfer Pathway Options

- Higher level math courses are permitted, if you begin with MAT 171
- Two semesters of a foreign language permitted
- Students MAY NOT take more than the designated number of courses in each pathway subject area (except math)
- Pathway COMPLETE = may continue to take courses in the full associated degree.
- May NOT substitute one pathway course for a course in another pathway.



#### **Placement Using Test Scores**

Eligibility for a transfer pathway may be demonstrated by achieving required scores on a single test or by combining test scores from any of the approved assessments.

Mathematics	24.5 / 510	530	22	75 or higher on Tier 1, 2, and 3

Calculus AB					3 or higher
Calculus BC					3 or higher
