

PHLEBOTOMY SPRING/FALL 2020 ADMISSION CRITERIA CERTIFICATE

A-B Tech is accepting students to the 2020 Phlebotomy Certificate. Programs will begin either Spring or Fall of 2020. All requirements must be met to be added to the program's eligibility list.

Admission Requirements

To be considered eligible for the Phlebotomy certificate, students must:

- Have applied to or attended A-B Tech within the past year.* You can apply online at: <http://www.abtech.edu/apply>
- Complete New Student Orientation:* <http://www.abtech.edu/nso>
- Attest to being a high school graduate or having completed a High School Equivalency or Adult High School diploma by the time the program begins.*
- Be age 18 or older by the first day of class.*
- Attend or listen to the required Phlebotomy Information Session and complete the PBT Assessment:* <https://www.abtech.edu/selective-limited-programs>
- Demonstrate college placement in English.* College placement can be met in multiple ways. Visit <https://www.abtech.edu/testing-center/placement-options> to learn more or consult with a Pre-Program advisor in Bailey. Official documentation is required.
- Meet with a Pre-Program advisor in the K. Ray Bailey Student Services Center to document eligibility and apply for the program.* Distance advising is available for students living outside of Buncombe and adjacent counties. Contact gotadvising@abtech.edu for assistance.

- Students must complete a background check and drug screening through college's third party vendor.
 - Directions for this process will be provided by the program **upon acceptance**.
 - DO NOT obtain these from another source; they will not be accepted.
