Private Pilot Flight Training (AER 151)

The FAA private pilot certificate (license) is a pre-admission requirement for enrollment into the Career Pilot Technology degree pathway.

Students who do not possess the private pilot certificate can enroll in the Aviation Management degree pathway initially. Once the private pilot certificate is obtained, students can enroll in the Career Pilot pathway and progress to their instrument rating (AER 161) and commercial pilot certificate (AER 171) flight training.

Students seeking to obtain the private pilot certificate are encouraged to take advantage of FAA-certified, Part 141 flight training at WNC Aviation, LLC (WNCA). For private pilot flight training fees at WNCA, visit the school's website at <u>beyourowncaption.com</u>.
