## All Pathways are designed to transfer to a four-year institution for eventual completion of a BA/BS degree.

The field of music is designed to prepare students for transfer to a four-year music program. The music pathway requires students to take first and second-year core courses in Music Theory, Music Appreciation, Introduction to Jazz and Chorus providing a foundation for students to pursue continued higher learning in music and/or a career in music.

Graduates in music will generally pursue careers such as music educator, composer/arranger, recording engineer, music administration, and music performance in a variety of genres.
