- Students attending A-B Tech can earn transfer credit by completing courses from the Common Course Library (CCL), as well as specified courses required by the Digital Media Technology A.A.S. program. Transfer credit is contingent upon an earned grade of 'C' or higher. Refer to the 2020FA-DME-UNCA-Articulation-120920 spreadsheet for general articulation courses.
- 2. Students will be asked to submit a portfolio of work to be evaluated by UNC-A faculty for possible credit for the following courses, to be determined by UNC-A New Media Faculty.

- To graduate from UNC Asheville, all students must complete at least 120 hours with a minimum of 60 semester hours from 4-year colleges. The final 30 hours must be completed at UNC Asheville and must include at least one-half the hours required for the major.
- 4. This agreement will terminate three years from the last signatory below or at any point in which either institution implements significant changes in the respective programs unless a renewal agreement is accepted by both institutions. Copies of the agreement will be distributed to the Vice President of Instructional Services at A-B Tech, the Dean of Natural Sciences at UNC Asheville, and both institutions' registrars and department chairs by June 15 of each year. Any updates to this agreement should be submitted by September 15. If curriculum changes occur in any of the courses identified in this agreement, parties from both institutions will review the changes and update the course equivalency outline.
- 5. Upon written notice, either party can terminate this agreement.
