- 1st Phase (Warning):

 - Meet with a Student Advisor (if Unclassified)
 - Student Success Seminar recommended
 - Individual success coaching available. You can reach a Success Coach at <u>advising@abtech.edu</u>.



College Standards: Academic Progress

- 2nd Phase (Probation Level I):
 - Meet with Program Advisor (if in a program)
 - Meet with a Student Advisor (if Unclassified)
 - Student Success Seminar required
 - "Limited to Term Plan" which means you can only register for courses on your next term plan.



College Standards: Academic Progress

- 3rd Phase (Probation Level II):
 - Follow same steps as Probation Level I
 - Complete Individual Academic Support Plan provided by our Support Services Office.
 - Schedule an appointment with a Counselor.

- 8. Believe in themselves




Successful Students...

- Attend and participate in class (even virtually)
- Start assignments early
- Concentrate on the material presented
- Take intentional notes
- Ask questions often
- Organize a study or homework network

- Utilize campus and community resources
- Attend review sessions
- Ask instructors and Advisor for assistance
- Create a study space
- Eliminate distractions
- Take breaks and rest





Success Strategies

- Start and stay organized all semester
 - Microsoft Office 365 available at no cost
- Make a "To Do" and "What's Due" List
 - Use a student planner for your deadlines
 - You can find these in Moodle and syllabi
- Schedule your study and social time separately
 - Limit social media and other entertainment
- Reward yourself after accomplishments



Tips for Success

- Set realistic goals (both big and small)
 - Small goal example = Pass BIO 168
 - Big goal example = Complete my ADN
- Establish healthy routines, eliminate unhealthy habits, and seek help with managing stress
- Self-advocacy is the key to student success
 - Know your limits and communicate often
 - Always ask for assistance if you're unsure
