PHLEBOTOMY SPRING 2023 ADMISSION CRITERIA CERTIFICATE

Beginning October 3, 2022, A-B Tech will start taking applications for the Spring 2023 Phlebotomy program.

All requirements must be met to be accepted to the certificate program.

Admission Requirements

To be considered eligible for the Phlebotomy certificate, students must:

Have applied to or attended A-B Tech within the past year. If needed, you can apply online at: abtech.edu/apply .
Meet New Student Orientation requirements: <u>abtech.edu/nso</u> .
Attest to being a high school graduate or having completed a High School Equivalency or Adult High School diploma by the time the program begins.
Be age 18 or older by the first day of class.
Complete the Phlebotomy Information Session at <u>abtech.edu/selective-limited-programs</u> and email a copy of the PBT Assessment to the Student Advising Team at <u>advising@abtech.edu</u>
Demonstrate college placement in English and math. College placement can be met in multiple ways. Visit abtech.edu/placement to learn more.
Meet with a Student Advisor located in the K. Ray Bailey Student Services building to document eligibility and apply for the Spring 2023 program. Students may come into the Bailey building anytime Monday through Thursday from 9am until 6pm and on Friday from 9am until 5pm for in-person services or schedule a virtual student advising appointment.

- It is recommended students interested in the Phlebotomy certificate complete General Psychology (PSY 150) prior to starting the program. This is **not** a requirement, only a recommendation.
- Students must complete a background check and drug screening through college's third-party vendor.

 - o DO NOT obtain these from another source; they will not be accepted.
- Phlebotomy students are strongly encouraged to complete Moodle Online Orientation prior to program start to be successful in 100% online classes.
