Apply online through the **AcademicWorks** online application system. Many A-B Tech scholarships can be applied for with a single application.

BEFORE APPLYING

1. Complete the A-B Tech admissions process.

Go to: abtech.edu/apply or visit the Admissions Office in the Bailey Building

- 2. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The A-B Tech school code is: 004033. Go to: www.fafsa.gov or visit the Financial Aid Office in the Bailey Building.
- 3. Access your A-B Tech student email account.
- 4. Submit a current official or unofficial transcript to the Admissions Office. (High school, GED or college transcripts)

SUBMITTING REFERENCES

- 1. Two (2) references are required.
- 2. Choose your references carefully.

References are encouraged from employment supervisors, managers, teachers, counselors, instructors or community leaders.

References from a family member or friend will not be accepted.

3. Reference forms are avaliable and submitted electronically via the scholarship application system.

(Creating Opportunities for Regional **Excellence**) Scholarship

The CORE Scholarship program provides a scholarship for two years at A-B Tech and then two years UNC Asheville. Qualifications: enroll in the A.A., A.E., A.S. transfer program with concentration on transferring to UNC Asheville, minimum 3.0 GPA, demonstrate a financial need by completing the FAFSA, be a resident of North Carolina. Preference given to students participating in the Bulldog Trailblazer Promise program.

SCHOLARSHIPS for College Transfer Students at A-B Tech and **UNC Asheville** Get up to \$2,000

Eligibility requirements will vary based on each individual scholarship criteria.



UNC Asheville offers the following scholarship opportunities for A-B Tech transfer students. The scholarships further unites A-B Tech and UNC Asheville in helping qualified local students pursue academic excellence while gaining skills for employment opportunities that benefit the community.

McKibbon CORE Scholarship

This scholarship was created by the McKibbon Hospitality Foundation. It is awarded to students enrolled in the College Transfer Program at A-B Tech who plan to transfer to and compleate a BA, BFA or BS degree at UNC Asheville. Other qualifications include a 3.5 GPA at both A-B Tech and UNC Asheville, be a full-time student (12 hours or more), be a resident of North Carolina, and demonstrate a financial need. Preference given to students participating in the Bulldog Trailblazer Promise program.
