BEFORE APPLYING

1. Complete the A-B Tech admissions process.

Go to: **abtech.edu/apply** or visit the Admissions Office in the Bailey Building

2. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

The A-B Tech school code is: 004033.

3. Access your A-B Tech student email account.

4. Submit a current official or unofficial transcript to the Admissions Office.
(High school, GED or college transcripts)

SUBMITTING REFERENCES

1. Two (2) references are required.

2. Choose your references carefully.

References are encouraged from employment supervisors, managers, teachers, counselors, instructors or community leaders.

References from a family member or friend will not be accepted.

3. Reference forms are available and submitted electronically via the scholarship application system.
