

# How to Decipher Course Codes



A-B Tech uses different letters to designate the location, delivery method, and time a class is offered.

**Location:** Classes offered at the A-B Tech Asheville Campus do not have a location identifier. Classes at other locations will use these identifiers. *Example: BDF-125-E1 will meet at A-B Tech Enka.*

**Delivery:** Classes offered at the A-B Tech Asheville Campus do not have a delivery identifier. Classes with other delivery methods will use these identifiers. *Example: AUT-116-1 is on Asheville Campus; HIS 111-OA3 meets online asynchronously (OA3).* 

# OA

## **Online Asynchronous**

100% of the instruction is online. Students and instructor do not meet online at the same time.



#### **Online Synchronous**

100% of the instruction is online. Students and instructor meet online at a designated day and time noted in the section information in Self Service.



#### **Seated Asynchronous**

Students may attend class in person at a set time noted in the section information in Self Service or access the class online at their convenience.



# **Seated Synchronous**

Students may attend in person or online at a set time noted in the section information in Self Service.



### Hybrid

51-99% of the instruction is delivered online. The remainder of the class time is in person.



#### Blended

50% or less of the instruction is online. The remainder of the class time is in person.

#### **Hy-Flex**

Instruction is delivered simultaneously in three ways: fully seated, online synchronous, and online asynchronous. Students can change their mode of attendance on any given week.

#### **Cross-listed**

Students from A-B Tech Main Campus and A-B Tech Madison will meet at the same time with same instructor. Instructor will be at one location and the other via Zoom.

**Time:** The standard time classes meet is 16 weeks. classes that meet a different number of weeks or on Fridays exclusively will use these identifiers. *Example ACA-122-BF1 is a Friday class.* 



Class meets on Friday exclusively

Late Start, class starts one, two, or three weeks after the semester starts. Class will end at the same time as 16-week classes.



Mini-mester, class meets either the first 8 weeks or the second 8 weeks of the semester.
