Associate in Arts: Creative Arts Pathway

All Pathways are designed to transfer to a four-year institution for eventual completion of a BA/BS degree.

The field of creative arts introduces the student to the basic concepts of art and art history. The creative arts pathway requires students to take first year core courses such as 2-D Design, 3-D Design, Drawing and Art History providing a foundation for continued higher learning in art and/or a career in an art related profession.

Graduates in this career path will generally pursue careers such as arts administration, museum studies, art director, gallery owner, art critic, art educator, art therapist, architect and interior designer.
