Associate in Arts: General Pathway

The Associate in Arts (A.A.) degree program is designed for students who plan to transfer to a college or university to pursue the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) degree. Upon the completion of the two-year degree, individuals are prepared to pursue coursework for any number of popular majors.

The A.A. curriculum, which totals 60 hours, includes the Universal General Education Transfer Component (UGETC), additional general education courses, and pre-major electives. UGETC is comprised of ten courses totaling 31-32 hours of credit that are guaranteed to fulfill general education requirements at any of the 16 universities in the University of North Carolina system. Additional general education courses provide students with a well-rounded education that focuses on humanities, mathematics and science, and personal health and wellness. Pre-major electives should be devoted to pre-major courses that prepare the student for the university degree of their choice.

The 2014 Comprehensive Articulation Agreement (CAA) and articulation agreements are agreements between the University of North Carolina system, some private colleges and universities, and institutions in the North Carolina Community College system. Information on the CAA and other articulation agreements are available on the Arts and Sciences / University Transfer webpage and from the Transfer Advising Center starting. A-B Tech offers over 150 courses applicable for the A.A. degree and suitable for transfer. Students who complete the Associate in Arts degree may transfer to senior institutions to pursue majors such as:

The General AA Pathway is available in traditional format or 100% online.

AA and AS degrees require completion of a minimum of 60 semester hours of credit, but pathways may include extra hours to meet university baccalaureate degree plans. Completion of hours beyond 60 may not be required to meet AA or AS graduation requirements but is recommended based on programs offered by intended transfer institutions.
