

RISE Referral

Revision Is Simply Essential!

RISE required sessions are available for students who have received a grade of 69 or below on a written assignment. Students may work with a tutor to compose a revision plan for their work and, at the discretion of their instructor, receive an improved grade upon the completion of their revised assignment.

RISE recommended sessions are available for students who would benefit from additional support in the development of their writing skills, such as grammar, punctuation, and paragraph construction.

Each major writing assignment receiving a grade of 69 or below will require a separate referral, but after a student is recorded as a RISE student in the Writing Center, **they may attend RISE recommended sessions at any time during the semester to practice writing fundamentals for an academic audience.** In order to receive any adjustments in an assignment's grade, as agreed upon between the student and their instructor, the student must use the RISE resource at least once for any major writing assignment on which they receive a grade of 69 or below.
